Day 1 (Monday May 31)

Depart Victoria via Air Canada

Day 2 (Tuesday June 1)

Arrive London Heathrow and transfer via motorcoach to Citadines Hotel (Trafalgar Sq.), an apartment-style property featuring full kitchens. Unpack and relax. Late afternoon subway to the London Eye for panoramic views of the city. Early evening welcome reception at the hotel.

Day 3 (Wednesday June 2)

Casual day. Orient yourself aboard the Big Bus tour. Evening free.

Day 4 (Thursday June 3)

Mid-morning guided walking tour of historic London. A visit to St. Paul's Cathedral and lunch at a local restaurant. Cross the Thames on the Millennium Bridge and enjoy a matinee performance at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre. Evening free to take in a West End show.

Day 5 (Friday June 4)

Morning visit to Kew Gardens followed by a backstage tour of the Royal Opera House. Explore Covent Gardens and in the evening attend a performance of the Royal Ballet.

Scenic Thames boat tour to Greenwich to join an architectural walking tour of this historic London neighbourhood. Evening free.

Day 8 (Monday June 7)

A day at Windsor Castle. Take the train to Windsor, tour the castle and enjoy a picnic lunch; afterwards, stroll the quaint village. Return to London. Supper at a traditional British restaurant (optional tour)

Day 9 (Tuesday June 8)

Watch a dance rehearsal in progress followed by Dim Sum in Chinatown. Wander through Soho to the British Museum for a guided tour. In the evening attend a dance performance at Sadler's Wells or a concert at the Royal Albert Hall (TBC).

Day 10 (Wednesday June 9)

Transfer to Heathrow and return to Victoria.
